It all started in St. Catharines, Ontario, with a couple of weirdos—Joshua Wood and Wesley Coderre. Within a small town, inside of a small garage, by a wood burning stove, the birth of Devil In The Wood Shack began. With a background of punk bands, jazz school, skateboarding and religious repression, they created a sound too unique to categorize and too catchy not to dance to. Officially forming in 2012, Devil in the Wood Shack has emerged as one of Vancouver’s folk-punk pioneers. But for them, it’s all about doing what they’ve always done—writing pop songs for weirdos, anthems for the lost and lonely, and bare-knuckle ballads for the underdogs. Now, four years after its birth, the band is releasing what some might call its ‘greatest hits’. The Self-Titled masterpiece is packed with 10 hard-hitting crowd favourites such as ‘You Keep Me Running’, ‘Maybe It Will Be Alright’ and ‘Lead’. In June 2016, this family-of-a-band will be touring across Canada to bring you the original sounds of Devil In The Wood Shack.
